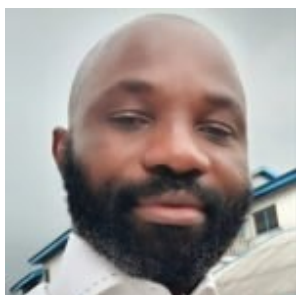
11) Alfredo Yuncoza
